





#### **FAST Assessment**


- Given 3 times per year in grades K-5
- Reading only
- Part of the Early Literacy Implementation legislation (ELI)
- Part of Consolidated Accountability and Support Application (CASA)




















### Differentiated Accountability

- State of Iowa has transitioned from five-year Department of Education site visits to an annual accountability monitoring system
- 2017-18 is the second year of this model
- Linn-Mar qualifies for supplemental support during the 2017-18 school year







#### Iowa Assessments


- •Given annually in 3<sup>rd</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grades

  - Core Composite























### **NWEA Assessments**
