Summer Reading Program Update: This summer we provided a summer reading program for students to help them get a “jump” on learning. Below is some information about our program from Director Lori Manley and Elementary Director of Teaching & Learning Karla Ries.

- Length: Held for five days (August 5-9)
- Student Hours: 9:00 AM -2:30 PM
- Students Enrolled: 60 (all elementary buildings represented)
- Classrooms: 4
- Teachers: 4
- Associates: 8 (Two per classroom: one general support and one designated adult for IEP students)
- Partnership: Marion Cares/FLY program to provide lunches
- Instructional Focus: All components of reading with heavy emphasis on early word recognition skills (especially phonological awareness and phonics)
- Who was Served: Kindergarten students who qualified by having one or more scores below benchmark for the winter 2019 and spring 2019 FAST screening periods

Extended School Year Services: Over the summer we also provide support for special education students that need extended services to continue work on their individual goals.

- Length: 5 weeks/18 days total
- Students Enrolled: 70
- Attendance: 84%
- Facilitator/Coordinator: 1
- Teachers: 12
- Associates: 39
- Nurse: 1
- Interpreter: 1
- Student Volunteers: 11
- Classrooms: 12

Summer Construction/Operations Updates:

The following construction/operations projects took place over summer break:

- Bowman Woods Elementary: Bathroom remodel, interior doors, security cameras and access controls installed, remodeling of the pods areas with carpet, ceilings, lighting, and cubbies
- Indian Creek Elementary: Bathroom remodel, lighting, ceilings, locker replacement, sewer lines, floor replacement, security cameras and access controls installed
- Wilkins Elementary: Bathroom remodel, roof work, new lockers, windows, lighting, and ceiling tiles
- Excelsior Middle School: Installation of security cameras and access controls
- Oak Ridge Middle School: Installation of security cameras and access controls
- High School: Roof work and rooftop unit replacement
- Success Center: Moved to new location off of C Avenue
- Hazel Point & Boulder Peak Intermediate Buildings: Construction continues on the new buildings
