### ❖ Perkins Priorities – FY23/24 Perkins Priorities

**Priority 2** - Promote CTE programs to include both general and special populations (TAG, students of color, and low-SES are currently underrepresented).

**Priority 3** – Improve student and staff safety through improved staff training and updates in tools and machinery.

  - 3. Does the district offer programs in which students choose to enroll and have an interest?
  - 4. Does the district offer a sufficient number of courses and course sections within programs?
  - 5. Are students sufficiently engaged in work-based-learning experiences?
  - 6. Does the district offer middle grades (5-8) CTE programs that connect to high school programming (minimum 7th and 8th)?
